



Research Assistant Volunteer Opportunity for International Medical Graduates

We have now opened up volunteer opportunities for International Medical Graduates (IMGs) to obtain Canadian experience in the role of clinical research assistant.

Selected candidates can expect the following:

- 3 month term, 2 or more days per week
- Study protocol and research principles training

Research Assistant Role:

- Assist with the administrative duties for the research study
- Complete patient follow-up visits over the phone (excellent spoken English required)
- Data entry and review of submitted study data
- Participation in office staff meetings

Upon successful completion of the 3 month term, the IMG is eligible to receive a letter of recommendation from the Executive Director detailing their experience, attendance, professionalism and performance during their volunteer term. Terms longer than 3 months may be possible.
